Dress Code for the MUN Osaka

Dressing properly for a conference such as the Model United Nations is very important. Since this is a formal assembly, formal clothing is to be worn by all participating schools and their students.

International business attire serves as our standard for our MUN with a slight modification given the weather in western Japan. Both males and females should wear a suit but we do recommend the “Cool Biz” style which has been adopted recently.

Clothing	Females	Males
Suits	A suit always looks professional. “Cool Biz” style is recommended.	A suit always looks professional. “Cool Biz” style is recommended.
Tops	No T-shirts. A blouse of any kind is appropriate. Short-sleeve is recommended.	No T-shirts or Polo shirts. A collared/button-down shirt is required. Short-sleeve is recommended. Tie is not required.
Bottoms	No jeans or shorts. Slacks and suit pants are acceptable. Skirts must be worn with stockings and should not be more than five centimeters above the knee. Avoid loud designs.	No jeans or shorts. Slacks, preferable in dark colors, are appropriate.
Shoes	No sneakers or open-toe sandals. High-heeled shoes may look nice but are not very comfortable.	No sneakers or open-toe sandals. Loafers or other types of dress shoes are preferred.
Hair	Keep hair clean and out of your face. No loud colors.	Keep hair clean and out of your face for a crisp, professional look.
Accessories	No accessories allowed.	No accessories allowed.

The main thing to remember is to be look sharp, and be well-covered. This is a public event and we wish that our participants appear both professional and well-groomed.
